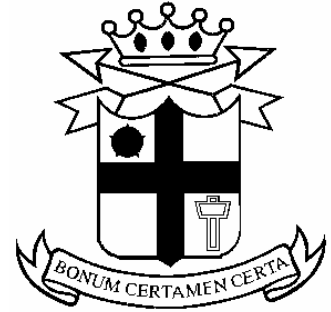

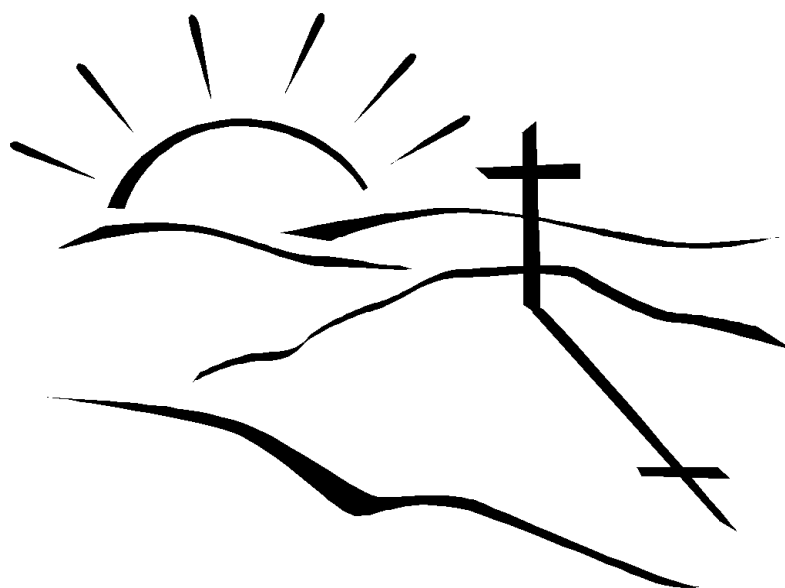

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE SCHOOL RULES:

Please spend a few minutes reading through this extract - It may avoid misunderstandings at a later date.

CONDUCT

We have the highest expectations of all pupils both in and out of school. They are representatives of St. George's R.C. High School on journeys to and from school, on school visits and in school teams.

APPEARANCE & UNIFORM

In matters of appearance and uniform, the school expects that full uniform should be worn at all times. Overcoats should be placed in school bags and kept in the lockers during the day. Sensible **plain black** shoes should be worn (NOT ballerina type). Boots and training shoes are **NOT** allowed. Pupils appearance must be reasonable and conventional; therefore dyeing hair in a manner which draws attention to itself and streaking of the hair, tram lines, head shaving, sculpting of hair and coloured hair extensions are not acceptable. **SMALL** black or burgundy bobbles only please. Parents are asked to check with the school if they have the slightest doubt about whether a particular hairstyle or item of clothing is acceptable. Girl's skirts are pleated with the St George's logo on the hem - available from "Ellesmere Embroidery" in Walkden or "Molly's Uniforms" 125 Manchester Road, Walkden. Girls also have the option of wearing **plain black** trousers. Trousers may be purchased along with all other uniform from the above retailers. Jeans and fashion garments are not allowed including visible brightly coloured belts and silver or gold shoulder bags. Jewellery and make up of any kind is **NOT** allowed especially lip gloss, mascara, eye liner and heavy foundation. Watches and dark coloured shoulder bags are permitted.

BOOKS & EQUIPMENT

The school expects all pupils to provide basic equipment for all lessons. Correct kit must be worn for all P.E. lessons. All details of homework set should be recorded in pupil planners. All exercise books must be free from graffiti. All pupils **MUST** bring to school a suitable bag for carrying homework books and equipment.

ABSENCE

All absences must be covered by a note from the pupil's parent or guardian. Educational research and data inform us that examination success is very closely linked with regular attendance. If a child is absent for any reason the school should be informed as soon as possible by telephone. Verbal messages from children are not acceptable. Brief absences from school during the day for medical reasons must be covered by a Pink Permission Slip issued by the school office. All pupils must report to the office when leaving school and when returning. All pupils must remain on-site throughout lunchtime. Pupils are not allowed to visit cafés or fast food suppliers.

BEHAVIOUR

School prefects are appointed in year 11. Their instructions **must** be followed. All damage, accidental or not must be reported to the Headteacher. In cases of negligence, it must be paid for. **24 hours notice will be given of any evening school detention. Detention is held between 3.05 and 3.35pm. It is the pupil's responsibility to inform parents/guardians about the forthcoming detention. (Pupils, who do not arrive for detention, will automatically attend detention the next day).** Sweets and snacks may only be eaten during break and lunch. The only exception to this rule is if a child suffers from Diabetes. Chewing gum is not allowed.

SMOKING/DRUGS/ALCOHOL

Smoking and the possession of cigarettes (including cigarette lighters and matches), alcohol or illegal substances is strictly forbidden at all times, including the journey to and from school. Pupils found smoking, drinking alcohol or taking drugs on their journey to and from school, will face a severe punishment. At all times pupils are expected to display the highest standards of behaviour and maintain the good name and reputation that the school holds.

VALUABLES

Pupils should not bring valuables into school. Money should be handed in to the school office during morning registration. Mobile phones and pagers are only permitted into school at the discretion of the Headteacher and must be left at the school office prior to registration every morning, clearly labelled with the child's name and form. If a mobile phone is confiscated by a member of staff, the pupil's parent will be asked to make an appointment to arrange for it to be collected from school at least 24 hours later. Valuables should not be left in lockers. Wherever possible a padlock should be used for security and a spare key left at the office.

MEDICINES/INHALERS

Pupils must not leave medicines/inhalers in their lockers or on their person. They are to be left (and will be available) at the school office. Please make sure all medicines are clearly marked with the pupils name and dosage where appropriate. An 'Administration of Medicine Form' must be filled in by a parent/carer and returned to school. This form is a legal requirement and can be obtained from the school office.
